**Fall Special Town Meeting Set for October 25, 2022**  
*Warrant containing 26 articles finalized*

LONGMEADOW (Oct. 4, 2022) – The Longmeadow Select Board finalized the Special Fall Town Meeting warrant at a meeting on Monday, October 3, 2022 for the Fall Special Town Meeting to be held on Tuesday, October 25, 2022 at 7:00pm at the Longmeadow High School, 95 Grassy Gutter Road, Longmeadow, MA.

The Fall Special Town Meeting warrant contains 26 articles to be voted on by registered voters of the Town of Longmeadow. Articles include a request for funding of a feasibility study for the middle schools, additional funding for the DPW to move forward on infrastructure projects, and adoption of a revised Code project updating and renumbering the general and zoning bylaws and implementing a new easy to use online format. The deadline to register to vote in the Fall Special Town Meeting is Saturday, October 15, 2022. Residents can register at the Town Clerk's Office at 20 Williams Street. If you are already registered to vote in general elections, you do not have to do a separate registration for Town Meeting.

Leading up to the Fall Special Town Meeting the Town Manager will be hosting a warrant information session at the Longmeadow Adult Center on October 19, 2022 from 6pm – 7:30pm to provide residents an opportunity to learn more about the warrant articles and ask questions. Article 1 on the warrant asks for funding of a feasibility study for the middle schools. In March 2022, the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) invited Longmeadow into a grant program to address the pressing physical plant needs of Glenbrook and Williams Middle Schools. In the current 270 day Eligibility Period, the District is working with the MSBA to fulfill several requirements including forming a building committee, completing a district enrollment study, and executing a commitment to fund and initiate a feasibility study. Upon completion of these requirements, the District would be considered for an invitation into the next phase of the MSBA capital pipeline. Public information sessions have been held on the middle school project, with the next session scheduled for Wednesday, October 12 at 1:00PM at the Adult Center.
